

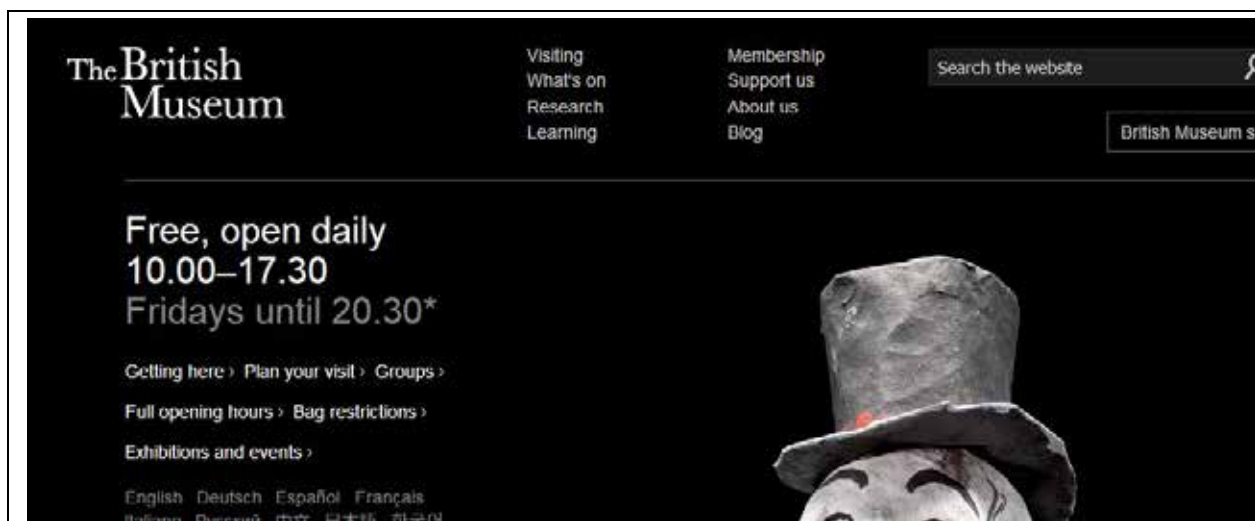

In 1598, the old library was refurbished to house a new collection of some 2,500 books, some of them given by Bodley himself. A librarian, Thomas James, was appointed, and the library finally opened on 8 November 1602.

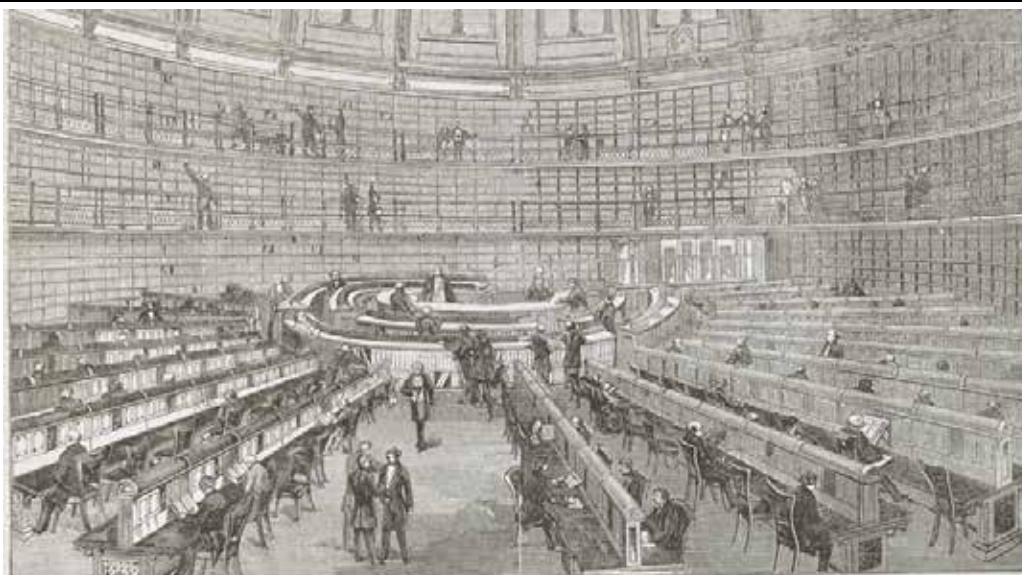
The British Museum was founded in 1753, the first national public museum in the world. From the beginning it granted free admission to all 'studious and curious persons'. The Reading Room (大英博物館圖書館閱覽室)

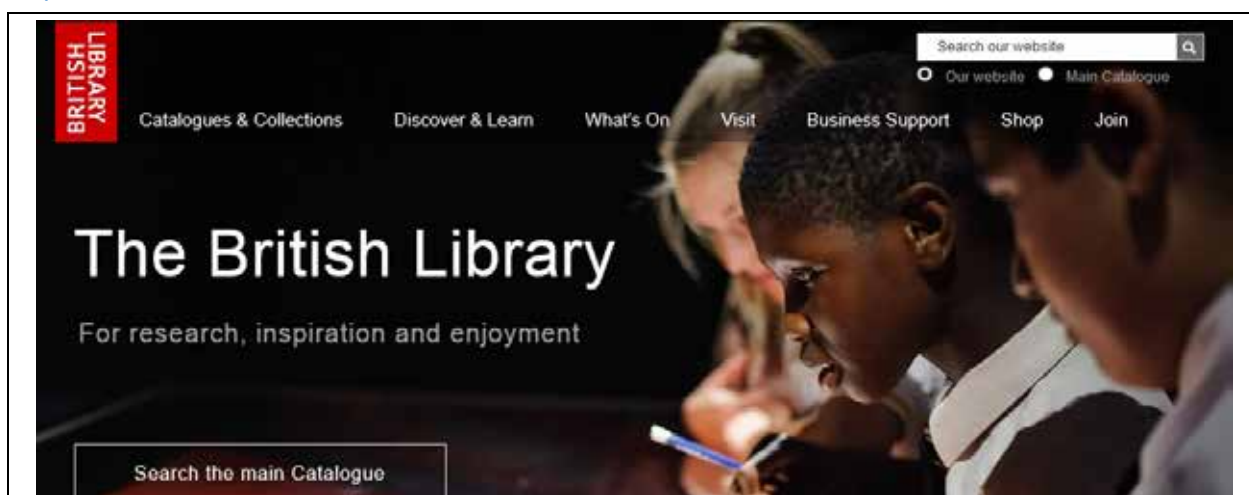

Lack of reading room space in the British Museum led Antonio Panizzi (1797-1879), the Keeper of Printed Books, to suggest the building of a new circular room, surrounded by four bookstacks in the central courtyard. Constructed of iron, the new building was designed by Sydney Smirke (1798-18770, brother of Sir Robert, and was built between 1854 and 1857.

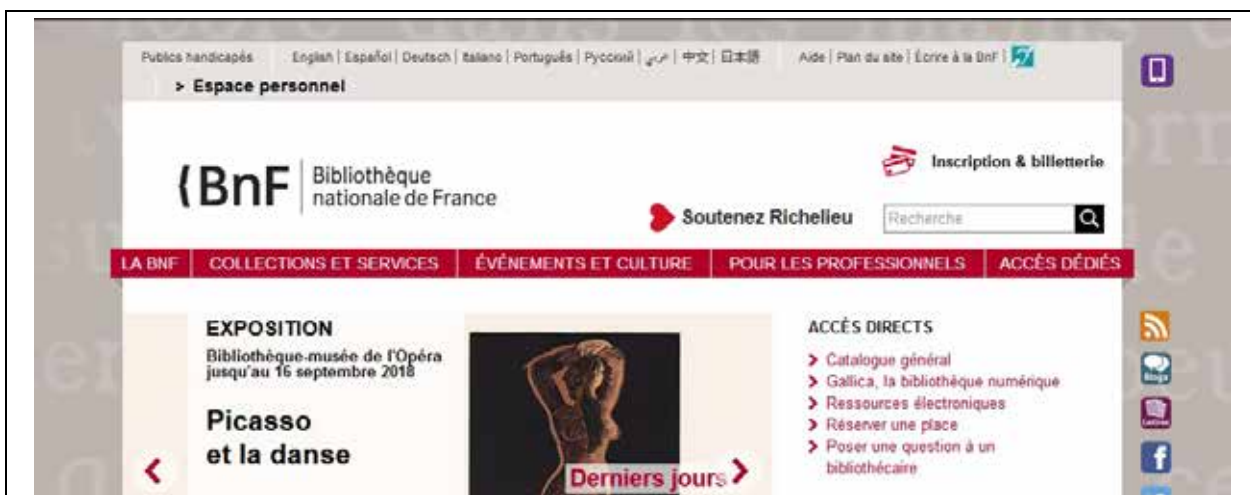

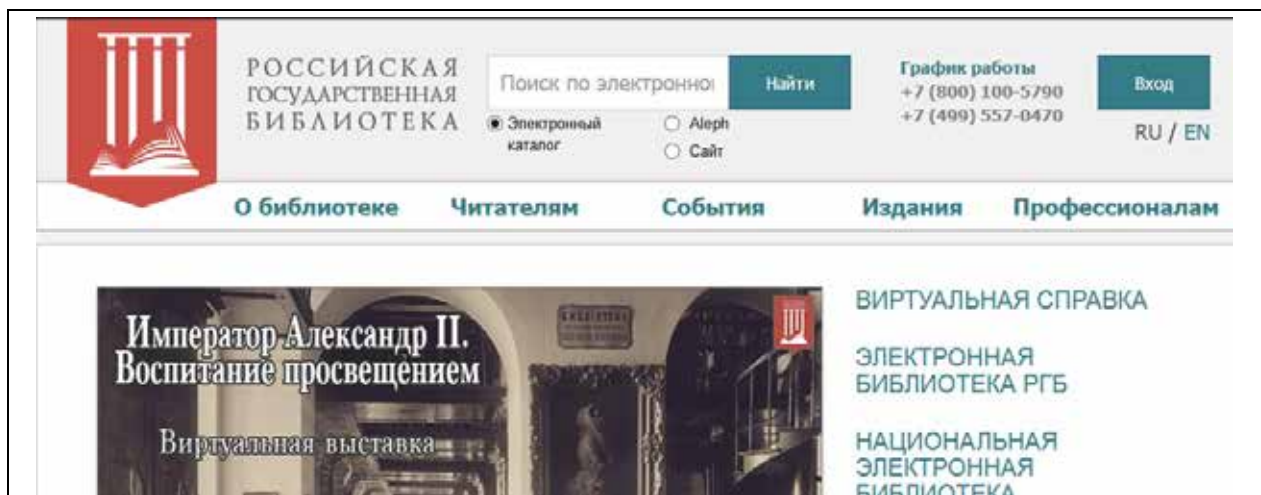
